Bury – Housing Needs Survey

Bury Parish Council requests your support by completing and returning the Housing Needs Survey that you will be receiving through the post (22nd February) .

The Parish Council wants to understand if there is a shortage of affordable housing for **local** people within Bury. The survey asks whether you would support the principle of providing affordable homes in the parish for people with a strong connection to the Parish and whether you have a need within your family.

This is an opportunity for you to express your views and/or highlight your needs. To ensure that all views are taken into consideration, it is important that everyone completes the form regardless of personal need. A high response rate sends a clearer message to the Parish and District Councils.

A separate survey form should be completed for each potential new household. Please contact Cambridgeshire ACRE (the contact details will be on the survey) if you require additional survey forms. They can also send forms to family members living away from Bury who would like to return to the parish.

The information that you provide is confidential. The Parish Council will neither see the completed forms nor have access to any personal information about individuals or households.

Thank you in advance for your time and assistance with this important initiative. The results will be reported to a future Parish Council meeting and will fed into our emerging Neighbourhood Plan.
